In fact, when a pub owner is killed Megan doesn't think it was truly an accident, but would someone actually kill because they weren't chosen? So while getting the family farm and store ready for the celebration she is also trying to pick the killer and it isn't as easy as picking a pepper or a pumpkin.

This was a pretty complex mystery with several suspects, means, and motives.
