This is a box set that is full of sweet, romantic mail order bride stories. These are not my typical read, but I liked them and they were enjoyable nonetheless. I was glad to have found these books in a box set otherwise I wouldn't have purchased them.

1. I believe the individual price is too high and is more than I would pay for such short books. These read more like a serial that stars different characters.
2. Also, the stories wrapped up fairly quickly after the brides found that they actually loved their husbands. It was to the point that they didn't feel absolutely complete.
3. While these are sweet romances, I prefer mine to be on the rated R side. These did have sex, though these are more like rated PG-15.

Book 1 ~ Mail Order Mayhem~ Maude finds that she is to be married to a much older man who gives her the serious creeps. She tells him no, but he informs her that she has no choice in the matter. She tries to tell her parents no, and they tell her that she will be married to the Horace. Having no choice and being desperate, Maude becomes the mail order bride for Harriet Long for a young farmer in Iowa.

Book 2~ Mail Order Mama~ Emily's mother comes to her as a newly engaged woman, whose bridegroom wants privacy and therefor Emily must find other arrangements, and she also has a bad job that has more responsibilities added to them without an increase of pay, she doesn't have much choice than to become a mail order bride. She goes to Minnesota to become the wife of a mercantile store owner and instant mother

to his two young daughters.

Book 3~ Mail Order Madness~ To escape a life where she has to watch over and care for her 11 younger siblings, commonly referred to as the “demon horde” because of their ill behavior, Susan becomes a mail order bride bound for Texas. But when she arrives, she learns that her fiancée was murdered when her older brother picks her up. He has a proposition for Susan, that she meet his family and become his wife and instant mother to his 4 young boys. At first they seem very well-behaved. But later learns that the wool had been pulled over her eyes.

Book 4~ Mail Order Mix Up~ Sisters Ellen and Malinda lost their mother at a young age and have just recently lost their father. They think they can manage until a banker comes to the house and gives them 3 days to get out. They in turn become mail order brides to brothers in Colorado. When they arrive, they find that they are instantly attracted to the opposite brother than to which they wrote! This is Ellen & Patrick's story.
