First, I will say that I really enjoyed this book and have enjoyed the series so far (despite some issues). The pacing is always excellent and even though the mythology is somewhat weird it works. The characters are well written. I like the ones that I like and I really hate the ones that I don't. Of course, I don't think I'm as attached to some of the characters as their importance to the story would normally cause, but that's not too big a deal.

The level of violence wasn't as bad in this book as in others in my opinion. There was some high school bullying, some gun and knife fighting, and some minor (nameless) character deaths. Darren kisses Debbie (who is his teacher). There was some cursing I believe, though it may have been made-up cursing rather than modern cursing.

There were some problems though. The fact that Steve returned only to betray them (especially with his elaborate plan) was cliche. I kept hoping that Steve really had shaped up and realized that Darren wasn't his enemy (I didn't really care if he hated Crepsley because not turning him and calling him evil was a pretty big insult), but I figured that the obvious would occur and that he was just leading them on. The thing with Debbie shows part of the reason that vampire romances are creepy: even though they are technically the same age, she is his teacher and thus it is extremely awkward for him to be crushing on her still... That and he still looks fifteen while she looks almost thirty.
