There can be no good urban fantasy story without some good use of all those magical powers flying around of course, and not too surprisingly, Luac and his nefarious plans provides Victoria with ample opportunity to practice her newfound powers. Things are complicated by the fact that Rhazdon hosts are, mostly due to past experience, considered evil and have a tendency to meet a premature end if exposed.

Well, Victoria is not much for following old and dusty traditions. Besides, who can resist a charming young girl carrying a freshly chopped off huge head of a ghastly beast. Okay she was dragging it . . . and she had help. But let's not get picky now shall we!

I guess I spilled the beans already in my review of Glow when I said that I was already reading book number three in the series so it should come as no surprise to anyone when I say that I quite liked this book.
