She hasn't been completely honest with her new boss and she's hoping that when she does tell him about her past that he'll see the valuable employee she's been... before he decides to fire her or not. What she wasn't expecting is to find one handsome bear shifter overcome at the side of the office building... as she was as she stood in the doorway.
