**REVIEW:** 3.5 stars--**PARADISE FOUND** by Vivian Arend is the second novella in the multi-authored contemporary adult **BANDICOOT COVE** erotic, romance series. This is Canadian pastry chef Paige Kingston, and Australian's Trent and Mason's story line.

**NOTE:** **PARADISE FOUND** is a M/F/M romance with sexually graphic scenes of ménage romance.

Told from three third person perspectives (Paige, Trent and Mason) **PARADISE FOUND** focuses on the ménage relationship between Paige, Trent and Mason. A special invitation to the resort island of Bandicoot Cove brings together a group of friends on behalf of Trent's sister Kylie. Sparks will fly between our trio knowing Paige will return to Canada when their mini-vacation is over.

Trent and Mason are best mates (friends), in love with the same woman, and both are hoping to make the relationship more permanent. Paige's visa is running out, and our heroine believes that the love she feels equally for both men may not be shared in return. When Paige gets wind of Trent and Mason's plans for the future, our heroine decides it is time to go home, leaving the men to venture forward on their own. What ensues is the fall out when secrets are kept in the hopes of surprising Paige with a chance for a future together with both men in her life.

**PARADISE FOUND** is an erotic story of romance with graphically detailed sexual scenarios of M/F/M situations. The sex scenes are intimate, intense and provocative-both men love Paige and want to spend the rest of their lives together but keeping secret their plans for the future causes a breakdown in communication and a brokenhearted Paige on the run.

Vivian Arend's PARADISE FOUND is a sexy and spicy story line with lively and inventive sex scenes where three people discover the intimacy and romance of their ongoing relationship. This is book two of this fantastic series and is the book written by the author I am most familiar with out of the three. Paige is a fantastic character. Uninhibited, a little insecure and a complete sweetheart, I adored her from the second we met her dressed in a French Maid's uniform, pretending to clean the room (Trent's fantasy is to have sex with a French maid). She is so sexually generous with them, because she loves them so much, so the fantasies she wants to fulfil aren't hers, they are theirs. Her issue isn't that she is in love with them both, her issue is that she may be forced to chose just the one of them, killing part of her heart, along with their friendship.

Trent and Mason are sweethearts. The central issue with these is these two is that they want Paige to be with them permanently, but they have no idea as to how. Both of these hunks worship the ground she walks on, would do almost anything for her (as can be shown by Masons reaction Trent having sex with the maid :D) and love the fact that she fits so well into their lives. For a second, Trent does feel a little weird about sharing the woman he loves with his best friend. That is until Mason puts his mind at ease

“I like doing stuff with you. It's...right. We fit, and I don't see any reason why we can't keep doing things together. Even important things like getting married and having a family”

As with the first story, I didn't see much character development with these two but I got a good sense of what lovely men they were by their treatment of Paige. Mason is protective and possessive whereas Trent is fun-loving and affectionate. A head-turning combination! The fella's have good intentions but, like in any good plan, there are many stumbling blocks. They try to keep their plan to seduce her into submission a complete surprise; of course that comes back to bite them on the arse.

I had no complaints with this book. There is no mystery, no ridiculous sub-plots or random twists that made me want to scream. This is just a story of people falling in love unexpectedly, taking a casual relationship into something perfect. Of course, the major problem with their relationship is that there are three of them in it!
