Lighthearted suspense and clean romance in a single little paperback? You bet it is! I'm not fully sure what I was expecting when I picked up this one, but it far exceeded any expectations I may have gone into *Undercover Holiday Fiancée* with.

This is a quick and very clean read with a focus on an undercover detective and a cop from a Special Victims Unit who have had previous cases together and unresolved feelings between them that they're struggling with while trying to tag-team the case presented in the plot. I'm not sure I can say much more than that (that hasn't already been stated in the summary blurb for the book) without giving some serious spoilers. But this was an entertaining and pretty well-written story for what it was. I will say that I think I would have liked to see more fleshing-out of all the characters, especially our two protagonists. Perhaps just a little more build-up on the romance between them in-story would have been nice as well, rather than just the nuggets of "their feelings for each other predate this case", and I do feel like there were a loose end or two that could have been tied up a little neater than what they were by the end.

All-in-all however, I did really enjoy this as a seasonal read and it was a lot of fun. Personally I'd also kind of classify this as a bit light on the actual "suspense" and probably better dubbed "crime drama", but it seems a bit light even for that label. The ending is definitely a sort of fluffy, feel-good little romantic moment, and it's utterly adorable and worth reading.
