The one thing that really bugged me about the book was the author's ongoing struggle with using correct terms and spelling issues. He wrote of an "eminent" event, rather than "imminent." The word "its" is always misspelled as "it's." He doesn't seem to know when to use "me" instead of "I." If it was a now-and-then thing, it wouldn't be a big deal. But it's a constant issue; I found it irritating and off-putting. It'll be interesting to find out if the issue continues in subsequent stories in the series.
