I purchased this book four years ago nearly to the day July 17, 2013. I remembered that I liked it and planned to re-read it, but apparently never got around to writing a review which was common for most of the stories/books I've read in the past (i.e. Stephen King, Dean Koontz, P. D. James, John Sandford, M. C. Beaton, etc. + several hundred western historical romances, along with Americana & Harlequin romances. And many older Westerns). The majority were paperbacks from used bookstores or hardcovers from the library. There was no Amazon back then.

Anyway I was surprised how much I enjoyed my second reading of this Unmated at Midnight series book. It was entertaining, amusing, before it made the reader upset, sad, then angry. Joyee Flynn is excellent at evoking emotions. Trevor was so sweet as the cute little Ribbon Garter Snake shifter. Innocent, defenseless

against larger controlling men / shifters who wanted to have someone to cruelly use and abuse. Unfortunately Trevor's small size, as well as his lack of any family or friends to come to his defense led to him being subjected to bullying, brutal assaults, degradation, and unmitigated fear.

Trevor was the perfect shifter for a millennia old Vampire to take under his protective wing. But the Vampire himself has his own set of problems as Colorado Springs Police Officer Kyle Moran. Being outted and feared in the department because he was not only a paranormal, but a "bloodthirsty" Vampire . He was discriminated against. His civil rights were trampled all over. But unlike Trevor, Kyle had friends, knew a lawyer, and he had money stashed from centuries of working so Kyle had a certain amount of freedom. A homeless, unemployed, abused small shifter did not.

Besides protection, Kyle brought something Trevor had never had a loving companionship, friends, a promising future, a job he was well suited for, and a bit boost to his self confidence. In return Trevor gave everything he was to Kyle and a very special mating present.

What a great way to spend a warm, but overcast Saturday afternoon with my Doxie companion, re-reading an engrossing story at the park.
