This was a hard one to rate. It jumped around from 1 Star to 5 Stars - see below if you want to know why.

Overall, this is an entertaining and unique series about vampires and wolf shifters, which I really enjoyed. I read books 1-7, which are all that are out so far. I'm glad I already had them all because it was only through Book 7 that all the MC's were left without any main open issues. If you stop at Book #6 - then you would have a group of MC's still separated and I, personally, would have been pissed! I would have given it a 1 Star

rating. I think it's a cheap way to force readers to buy the next book.

Each book was shorter than I thought it would be. Each book does have a complete love story with new main MC's that are sexy, unique and intriguing. There is also an overall story about their world being weaved through all the books that binds them together but does not ever finish. Sometimes, something happens to a couple MC's from a previous book and you need to read the next books to get resolution, otherwise it's a cliff hanger (and I HATE when that happens directly to the MC's).
