First of all, the book description for this is especially crappy. Even by we're-a-small-epub,-so-let's-get-the-unpaid-intern-to-write-it standards. Julian is actually over 800 yrs old, not 400. And maybe it's just me and my dirty mind, but the blurb made it seem that Julian's love interest was . . . his daughter. No?

Actually, Julian's love interest is the daughter of the baddie that he killed in the first installment of the series: Spark of Magic. The baddie is dead but the bad dudes wanna resurrect him. That's the thing with paranormal tales featuring magic. Nothing is ever final.

The world TAM creates is a threadbare one where warlocks/witches, vampires, and werewolves all exist. It's the type where a character waves his hand and he travels from USA to the UK in one sec. Such a world lacks gravitas for me so I doubt I will be continuing with the series.

As for the smut, it was hot, as usual, but the actual menage story development sucked since the third in the menage was shortchanged and underdeveloped.

Content warning: a lot more M/M touching and sucking than you normally find in a TAM story, menage, DP.

She is also a witch like Rebecca (Spark of Magic), but is beginning to feel the changes of her turning to a full vampire on her 25th birthday. Who better to save the day than Julian and his werewolf friend Andre. Addison came to seek Marcus's help but Dad intervened and stepped in his place. So, that's where their relations began.

It's quite...what's the word...funny? Weird? Awkward? to have your father's former lover turn his amorous attentions to you. Given that vampires succumb to ennui having that lifespan, maybe they could do whatever

they want just to try something new.

I didn't mind the Julian and Andre kissing or blowing each other here. I'm not saying I'm a fan, but after this, I can say I'm able to tolerate those if the writing is as smooth as this. I can stand females kissing and even having sex with females, but the males? That's on a case to case basis.

So finally, after all the escaping, sex, training, sex, moving to another location, sex and more sex, Addison was finally taken to the dead vampire's lair to complete the Blood Rite. Sebastian's end was tastefully done I might say, and the threesome relationship worked for them.

I'll be checking out her other works. If you're the type who's searching for a serious storyline with depth and character development and all that literature jazz, then this is not the book for you. However, if you just want a fun read with magic and vampires and a lot of sex, you'll enjoy this.
