Absolutely NOT what I was expecting. This story was slow to start for me, but that's not necessarily a bad thing, as we begin the story at the end of the situation: the aftermath. Some thrillers are dark and disturbing. Luckily, this one is a book filled with strength and a strong sense of the struggle for survival, while having some dark and disturbing imagery. If I had to come up with one word to describe Tori, the main character, it would definitely be "survivor". Most of this book happens in the past tense as Tori recounts her history. I think that was very clever of the author because the imagery was so detailed and vivid that if it were happening in "real time" it would have seemed too graphic. Strange, I know, but for me it is less traumatic to see a description of the past than to read something traumatic as it happens. The author also did an excellent job of building up the story, weaving through everything that happened, building up each of the characters more and more....but sneakily not giving you all the information.
