I read this last month. And, while I have not yet seen this film, I did enjoy these 2 short stories. I especially like the art in these stories.

Cute childrens book suitable for younger toddlers. The artwork is beautiful, and my favorite part of either story. The storyline is simplistic and lacks subtlety, but that's to be expected for the targeted age group. While it lacks the layered plotlines and rich character arcs of the source material, it's fine as a bedtime story for a young Frozen fanatic.

I would rate this a 5 star because the story is great and the artwork, of what you can view, is amazing. However, the pictures were cut off and you couldn't view the story in its full format on the Kindle. I would recommend not purchasing this story until they have reformatted it so you can view all of the pictures. However, if your looking for a book to purchase in paper format or loan from the library it's a fun one to read.

I didn't realize this was two books in one. When we got to the middle of the book, all of a sudden the pages were upside down! Haha. Flip it over and read the other story.

Both stories follow the Frozen storyline. Each one focuses on one of their stories. It's kind of fun to see the perspective of both sisters on the situations that occur. I think it's a unique idea for a kids book to show those different perspectives so that they can start learning early that everyone views things differently but it doesn't mean it's wrong.

The illustrations were abstract versions of the characters. My daughter was still able to tell who was who though, so that was impressive! Both stories were pretty short, so even though we read both, my daughter didn't get bored.

If you have a Frozen fan, you should pick this up.

Selena says

Compared to A Sister More Like Me, this one fell flat. The artwork was static, and the stories was just a rehash of the climax of the movie. There wasn't any point in reading it.

Worse, they felt the need to SPELL OUT the reason for the titles, because apparently no one can figure out what the story was about unless they SPELL OUT the title in bold letters every time the phrase appeared. So they SPELLED OUT the title at least four times in each story. When the story's just summing up the "exciting bits" of the movie (and not very well, either), you don't really need to SPELL OUT the title on every page.

If you're gonna pick a Frozen picture book, I would advise it not be this one.
