I enjoy B.J. Harvey's books, but this one was my less favorite.

I had NO problem with STD plot, I even liked that the author finally spoke about this issue.

There are so many manwhores in the romance world, who slept with half of earth population, and always stayed clean. It's impossible!!! I respect this author for real approach of "active" sexual life with many partners.

BUT!!! I had a problem *how* this male protagonist/MP got "infected" and *what* he did afterwards.

He didn't get Chlamydia from his permanent f\*ck-buddy, not from a woman he knew and exchanged health information, no, he slept with a random woman (who he met 2 times) WITHOUT condom! He neither forgot to wear condom nor the condom failed – he didn't put it on purpose.

I loved these two together!
