It is her mission to meet Ian Scott and plant spy amulets within the walls of the Brevis retreat. She completes her mission but is unaware that the amulets are also set to kill everyone living at the retreat. She is also unaware of the fact that she has Sentinel blood running through her veins. Ian is on a forced leave of absence due to burnout from his job as an amulet technician at the Brevis lab and think tank. His job--to figure out how to detect and disarm silent working amulets.

This is the eighth book in Durgin's Sentinel series. I actually gave this book a 3.75 out of 5.0 rating. The only reason I didn't give it a 4.0 was because it dragged in places.

In each story about the Sentinels, the premise has been extremely unique with a spirited couple. When an enemy is able to get close to the man who is diligently

looking for a solution to the Sentinels problem, their choices can either lead to them having a bright future or cut it short. The clever imagination of Doranna Durgin creates a paranormal story that is totally fascinating all the way through. **SENTINELS: LEOPARD ENCHANTED** intrigues with inventive details plus distinctive characters.

Being a technician for the Sentinels makes Ian Scott proud, especially when he can help save lives. However, his current project is causing him much aggravation, because he has failed to think up a way to guard those like himself from the amulets developed by their enemy, the Atrum Core. Though his foes are not supposed to cause any type of problems for his group, it has not stopped them from covertly trying. Frustrated because he cannot safeguard those who are protectors of the earth, Ian needs an outlet for his pent-up worrying. When he meets Ana Dikau, he believes she might be able take his mind off any troubles, at least for a short spell.

As a member of the Atrum Core plus being a woman, Ana has never been shown respect. In order to prove her worth, she has accepted an assignment to interact with Ian and secretly put an amulet in the place where he is staying. Though she has been taught to be very afraid of this man who can shapeshift into a snow leopard, she finds him to be considerate and enjoys being with him. What Ana does not realize is that the people with whom she works are much more devious than she knows, putting her and all the Sentinels in danger.

Originality is a word frequently associated with the Sentinels series. From innovative threats to unusual abilities, Doranna Durgin always comes up with something atypical to incorporate into the story. Creativity in every situation makes **SENTINELS: LEOPARD ENCHANTED** particularly enthralling. The series often has me wondering about the possibility of hidden groups fighting each other, and how humanity could be in serious trouble if the wrong one wins. In this book, only certain individuals are facing jeopardy but the risk to others is high if the Atrum Core succeeds. Ms. Durgin certainly added lots of suspense to the story with all the nonstop risks from the beginning.

When it comes to heroes, some are undeniably alpha while others have more beta traits. Ian possesses the best of both, making him someone I truly loved regardless of whether his take charge attitude was showing or it was his compassionate side being demonstrated. Ana has been taught to not trust any Sentinel, yet the protective nature of Ian makes her feel special for the first time in her life. Though sex between them starts off casual, it quickly turns into much more for both of them. When her deception is exposed, plenty of emotional scenes follow. During the story, a large number of previous characters make an appearance to my delight. With even more adversaries surfacing to challenge the Sentinels, the next book should be doubly exciting. **SENTINELS: LEOPARD ENCHANTED** captivates with ground-breaking adventures.

Leopard Enchantment starts off with a nice amount of intensity to the attraction between Sentinel Ian Scott and Ana Daiku who is a newbie spy for the enemy. I like enemies to lovers stories, but that trope is fairly subtle here since Ian doesn't know that Ana is the enemy and Ana is very sweet and isn't so wrapped up in the propaganda of her 'people' that she can't help but liking Ian and the other Sentinels that she interacts with - so the 'betrayal' when Ana is outed - and the consequences of that- is the big conflict for the pair.

I have been reading the Sentinels since their 'Nocturne' days and I am still hooked on the series. I really liked this pairing. I loved Ian in all of his borderline geekiness and Ana was very likable and I thought it was great that she quickly finds her own strength when she finds out how she's been manipulated by her handler.
