Superman is in protective mode, he's even had a high school planned already, and wants to move out of the metropolis and go to Smallville, but Lois won't have any of that. Neither will she stop doing her job. So, while following up on a lead, her and her partner are ambushed by the Joker & Harley Quinn and Jimmy, her partner catches a bullet...
