The T-Rex and his two little human companions, whose previous adventures are chronicled in Tea Rex and Camp Rex, return in this third picture-book, this time heading to the beach for some fun in the sun. The simple narrative gives instructions on the proper way to comport oneself at the shore - putting on sunscreen, waiting to take a dip after eating, swimming with a partner - while the artwork captures all the fun that dinosaurs and children have together.

Although Sea Rex is the third book about this genial T-Rex and his human friends, it is only the second I have read, not being currently able to track down the second title, Camp Rex. I enjoyed it as much as the first (Tea Rex), and thought the faux-instructional narrative worked particularly well when contrasted with the more zany illustrations. The artwork, as is always the case with Molly Idle's books, is really lovely, cute but also beautiful (the two are not always the same thing). Recommended to anyone who has read and enjoyed the earlier *Tea Rex* books, and to anyone searching for entertaining seashore adventures for the picture-book set.
