This the third in her series is actually the best of the three but still not that great. It is still mostly a romance trotted out as erotica. There is definitely chemistry between Conner and Mischa from the moment they see each other at mutual friend's engagement party in Seattle, he friends with the groom and she friends of the bride (the couple from book one). And because Mischa is from San Francisco, they both ascribe to the notion that they can have great sex in the few weeks leading up to the wedding while Mischa is in town helping with wedding prep and making plans to expand her business with another branch in Seattle. Mischa is a tattoo artist and Conner does sci-fi design art for game systems.

Both characters are commitment phobic as is usually the case. Both had rocky childhoods, her perhaps worse than his. Though in an odd twist he actually thinks worse of himself than she does. It's all just sort of old hat, blasé. Even the sex scenes are kind of lukewarm.

And my on-going gripe about this author is that her endings are never done particularly well. She just sort of plops a "TA-DA" down and calls it an ending.

Temptation's Edge started out really well, and the last few chapters were good too. I had trouble trying to keep my concentration on the story, between those two parts. I know the cause of it, though, and I will explain shortly.

I had no idea that this book was part of a series when I started reading it. It wasn't until Mischa was having dinner with two other couples (and a single Irishman) that I realized this was the third book. However, you can read this story as a standalone. Otherwise, I would have stopped reading it until I read the others first. It just irks me to read a series out of order that had a cliffhanger ending or unanswered questions from previous books.

Now, on to the reason for my loss of concentration. I don't mind reading about BDSM. This book goes a little further with the BDSM play than *Fifty Shades*, and that's OK. But, in the first part of the book, Connor takes Mischa to a BDSM club. I really didn't know what to expect, but I was curious. Although I know this is fiction (and sometimes I overthink things), I just couldn't stop thinking about that part. There wasn't anything bad, it simply wasn't my cup of tea. So, it was hard to focus on the story afterwards. I felt like, maybe, if that scene would have been a little later on in the book (after I was invested in the characters and their story), I wouldn't have minded it as much. When I stopped reading then, and finished the book the following day, I was able to enjoy the last few chapters.

I liked that Mischa and Connor were both headstrong characters. (Of course, he's a dominant. With an Irish accent, I might add. Even though that has nothing to do with anything I just said.) Their whole 'I-can't-let-you-hurt-me-so-I-will-deny-my-feelings' thing was starting to grate on my nerves, which is weird because I, normally, like the angst. Maybe it just went on too long.

Still, it's not a bad book. The plot was good, but I did read some reviews that said it was almost exactly like

the first two books. I wouldn't know anything about that seeing as how I haven't read them. I would recommend this book to Eden Bradley (Eve Berlin) fans and people who read BDSM romances.

I will admit, this one is not one of my frequently visited genres to read. I picked this up at the grocery store (I kid you not) thinking it was something other than an erotica romance novel so it was a bit disconcerting to realize it was more focused on sex than what I expected.

Recommend this one for those who prefer a bit more romance with their erotica romance a bit darker with more emotional angst between the lovers. This is not straight up erotica, but more erotica romance because there is a constant abundance of the characters having inner dialogues about the emotional turmoil they go through after "bottoming out" after the sex. If you are expecting just a plain "hot, dirty erotica" novel then you might be disappointed with the more emotional dialogue each character has afterwards. If you want just a novel with hot sex with no real emotional connection or no real connection forged outside the physical, then you might want to reconsider as it can be a bit jarring to come to if you aren't expecting it.

Also, be warned that this is the third book in the trilogy. I have not read the previous two yet so I do not know if it makes me miss out on understanding anything on a more subtle level with appearances from previous characters or not. The sex can push the limits for some readers so please read the description of the novel on the book as it is mostly BDSM type style at certain scenes. Overall, it is mostly BDSM type style a bit more than say 50 shades of Grey (which I will admit, I disliked as I found it unrealistic, disturbing and hilarious ...because I have an odd sense of humor.. depending on the scene). I will admit, this is not one of my regular genres to read as I prefer a bit more mystery or plot than just dealing with the two lead characters learning about each other and having sex all the time. Oddly enough, I picked this one up at the grocery store thinking it was something else. I did like it enough to be curious about the author's previous books as well as to see what else she has got out there. Again, recommend for those who want erotica romance with a bit of angst, but the focus to stay on the two leads.
