As head of a major clothing firm and a rich bachelor he finds himself the focus of a lifestyle he is no longer comfortable with. He hopes a remote home location will give him a chance to figure out what he wants. Sasha is a bestselling author who finds Martha's Vineyard a perfect location for her writing and still has easy access to NY when she needs to work with her publisher. Doug is drawn to Sasha but Sasha is wary of his reputation and is fiercely protective of her independence. Sasha has been the focus of a series of 'accidents' that escalate and draw the two of them together in trying to figure out who is stalking her. Very 80s in style but a satisfying early work of Delinsky.
