What I liked - As unsafe and unrealistic as it would be in real life, I really liked the quick rescue and roommate situation. I like that they became close friends first and built a relationship on friendship and love first before they started sleeping together. I loved the drunk sandwich scene. That sounds weird, I know, but it was a great part of the book. There was just much familiarity, and they were so comfortable with each other and joking around and having fun. At the same time, they were having real discussions, and I just think it was a special series of moments. It seemed like I was watching their relationship grow and solidify.

What I didn't like - There were some avoidable, or at least obvious and correctable, mistakes with the editing. I have never liked it in books with multiple partners where someone goes into a speech, though the one in this book was small, about the characteristics of each partner and how they're different but both good, etc. Showing these things is enough. The speeches are awkward and unnecessary and don't remotely sound like natural dialogue. I didn't like that Brett had had threesomes before. That's probably unfair of me, but it's how I feel. It makes this relationship feel a little less special than I would have thought otherwise. When writing about polyamory, she described a devil's threeway as MMF. It's not. It's MFM. There's a difference. She was writing it about herself, and her guys are not with each other, so her terminology is incorrect. While it had an HEA, the ending itself was weird.

Overall - This book is a cool creative take on a threesome relationship. It was decent but could have been much better.

Lyn is on her way to a new life when things start to go wrong. Her cell battery dies after a call where her would be roommate bails on her, then her car dies. It seems like nothing is going to go right for her as she gets ready to spend the night in her car. Then a policeman approaches her car and asks if she's alright. His partner and he talk her into staying the night in their spare room so that she's safe for the evening, not wanting to leave anyone on the side of the road. What seems to be a bad luck run just got amazingly better as she scores the intern position at the magazine she wanted, a job she can do and enjoy until she starts getting published, and 2 new best friends that she has decidedly more than friendly feelings for. But her mentor is pushing her, her feelings are pushing her boundaries and time is getting away from her. Something has to give and soon.

I read The Cabin first and saw the link to this one in the back. While I enjoyed it this one resonates more. The bonds forming that support the type of relationship being built are what make this story amazing. For people who aren't used to untraditional relationships there has to be more than lust or the foundation shakes apart quickly. The guys had been partners for years at work. They bonded further when Brett divorced and Derek offered him a room. When Lyn came into their lives that closeness helped keep things from devolving into jealousy and fights. As I'm sure they had to have at the apartment while she was at work. Especially as some of the things they say indicate they had some heart to heart talks. But all in all a great story. FMC is young but not flighty; hard working and ambitious. The guys are more than background noise and have distinct personalities, career goals and a strong friendship despite their different personalities. Even though this was fiction it felt a little more grounded in reality.

Lynette's car breaks down on her way into the city after she found out she no longer had a place to live and her phone died. She'd accepted an unpaid internship at a magazine and had very little money to live on until she found a paying job she could do in the evenings. Off-duty cops Derek and Brett stop to help her and eventually she agrees to stay in their spare room for the night. I was a little put off by how reluctant she was to go with them. They were in uniform, driving a cruiser and had her confirm their ID's via Brett's phone. Did she really think she'd be safe sleeping in her car?

That set the stage for the development of the story and gave insight into how naive and stubborn Lyn could be. She's attracted to both men but worried what her dad will think if he finds out. She sometimes sounded younger than she was. I think the conflict with her dad was unnecessary and didn't really add to the story.

This is not your typical menage where there are two men looking for the right woman to have a 3-way relationship. In this case, Derek and Brett weren't looking for that but when they discovered the perfect woman for each of them, they decided they could share her. The tempo of the book would often change from hot sex one night to an innocent peck on the cheek the next night. Sometimes it was hard to understand the change because Lyn didn't seem too conflicted, just tired. By the way, handcuffs never make an appearance so the title is misleading.

The author really developed an outside story for Lyn so this wasn't just about her relationship with her two hot cops. It was about her career development as well. At times that was nice and at times it seemed to slow the story down and drag things out.

I think the story would have benefited from some thoughtful editing eliminating some unnecessary sections and moving the story along in one direction instead of swinging back and forth with the relationship. More diversity in the bedroom would have also been nice. The author teased with a single thought about DP but it was never discussed again so some of the scenes were similar to others.

Overall, it was a good book with good character development. If possible, I would have given it 3.5 stars for the reasons mentioned above. I would read another book by this author so I feel her writing is definitely worth my time, as long as I don't see the same issues again.
