Lynn is haunted by the past and by the death of her family, but feels at home with Cole and Molly, her new kind of family. But with Molly returning to Prospect Springs, things are going to change, though the last thing that Lynn expects is to be drawn to the town doctor, Parker. Parker is teased for being a skirt chaser, despite the fact that he barely does at all. Yet being around Lynn does something to him and he can't help but want her for himself.

This is the second book in the Prospect Springs Shifter series, and I'm going to bring up one of the same points that I did with Blaze of Glory. I really liked how the book managed to capture a lot of different genres and tie them all together in a way that just worked. The Western style culture, alongside space travel and supernaturals doesn't necessarily sound like a recipe for success, but I found myself completely sucked back into the world.

Theoretically each book is a stand alone romance, but I would say that I think they should be read in order. There is a slight overlap between the end of Blaze of Glory and the beginning of Parker's Honor, but actually it worked more as a continuation of what happened after the events.

I loved Parker and Lynn's relationship. Even though this is a fated shifter thing (meaning I have little problem with the insta-love) they didn't quite have that. Instead they first were physically attracted to each other, and then had the moment of intellectually being attracted to each other (while Lynn was holding her own at Parker's practice and helping him out) and then came the more love like feelings. For me it worked and I liked reading the progression.

This series is definitely fun! And the books provide interesting (and short) reads!

This is the second book in the Prospect Springs Shifters series. Though it would stand alone, I believe it best

to read both and in order.

While Jon and Molly were getting reacquainted (see *Blaze of Glory*), Parker MacSweeny is peeling back the layers to discover who Lynn is. She isn't Molly. She also isn't Lynn..., but she is his mate. Though he has never had an interest in monogamy, his wolf has already claimed her. Will she accept the claim? Will he discover her deepest secrets?

I am not admitting how long I stayed on the treadmill with this one... if I admit it, I'll be expected to walk that long every day! Let me just say, I couldn't quit until I knew the answers. My only complaint is that the next book isn't yet ready!!

I loved Molly in *Blaze of Glory*, just because of what she was willing to do for her friend. Now I love her even more. Her family story broke my heart; I just wanted to hug her and tell her that it's not her fault what others may believe. When you know the truth, the rest is petty jealousies or fear. She is such a strong and smart girl. We should all aspire to be her. Doc/Parker needed to be clouted upside the head and I cheered when his mother finally did it!

****What is good about it?****

Her grammar, spelling, and sentence structure were very well done. Kudos to Team Roth.

I think this story contrasts the 1st in that she was less focused on the scenery, location, or technology and more focused on the relationships. ****What doesn't work?****

The shifter life of claiming someone in less than 24 hours seems abrupt in comparison with the 1st novel's timeline of 10+ years of familiarity.

****Summary****

Overall it was a VERY quick read that kept me curious about what was to happen next. There was enough erotica to make me squirm, struggle to keep my interest and a quite bit of humor to keep me chuckling often. I would rate it a B.

Parker's Honor is the second novella in what will undoubtedly be another outstanding book by Mandy Roth. Although this book is only about 87 pages, Mandy writes with such clarity that with just a couple sentences she is able to set the scene, provide the backdrop and time, establish that we are dealing with paranormals and outlaws and TWO Molly's newly come home.

The real Molly is Johnathan's mate, but the outlaws want to kill her. The second Molly (her best friend) looks enough like her to impersonate her, and has some paranormal characteristics that can protect not just Molly, but Parker, too.

Parker is confused.

He sees the two Mollys, but the one claiming to be Johnathan's Molly, is not her, she's Parker's mate. Meanwhile the real Molly has gone off with Johnathan, her true mate. Leaving Parker and Lynn (the Molly lookalike) to fend off the outlaws. The outlaws attack and Parker attempts to shield his mate (Honor Lynn). She actually saves him. She fires one shot from her gun and knocks out two outlaws... 'just as her daddy

taught her'. I love that Mandy creates heroines that are equal matches for their alpha heroes.

He's a surgeon, she is too. When Parker's parents arrive on the scene their antics to drive their son crazy will have you laughing. Momma wants grand kids!! Papa loves Honor Lynn as a daughter as much as his wife does and the two of them gang up on poor Parker! He doesn't stand a chance; and he doesn't want to. She is HIS!

Parker's Honor is the second book in Mandy Roth's scify/paranormal "Prospect Springs Shifters". Creatively this story begins at the same place and time as the first book, but is the story of Parker and Lynn and is enjoyably told through their perspectives. I highly recommend reading Blaze of Glory first as it sets the storylines, settings and characters up.

I actually enjoyed this second book even more than the first as there further and more indepth world building which enable me to paint a better picture of this futuristic, post apocalyptic, western scify shape shifting setting.

Parker is not only a hunky alpha hero who comes to the aid of Lynn (pretending to be Molly in book 1), he is also an intelligent, empathetic and dedicated doctor. On top of all this Parker is also a shapeshifting werewolf as are most of the hot men in the huge MacSweeney family.
