Authors writing style: I have read a few of Aubrey's other books and loved them. This was another good read by Aubrey. The writing style is very detailed with little repeating of lines or mistakes. The characters are easy to connect too. I couldn't connect to the environment in which this story takes place (Whitehouse), but the characters had a good bond and allowed you to see past the environment. This was a standalone story of a soon to be stepbrother from the military. Both characters are over 18 years old (college and 4 years of military service).
