How to explain this book. Something like a poorly written porno with a bad case of borderline beastiality. Well, I guess I should start with the story. Yes, the "story" starts with our cosmopolitan-sounding heroine getting stood up for a date with her douchebag of a boyfriend. As luck would have it, she runs into a mysterious stranger -- a mysterious HAIRY stranger. The two of them hit it off pretty well -- they end up having first-night sex. And as they have sex, they describe in gory detail things that I did not want to be described in gory detail.

But as it turns out, this is a one night stand of sorts because the mysterious man disappears. He disappears because he has a secret -- two secrets. One secret is that he's a marine. The other secret is that he has a special power that allows him to turn into a bear. (Strangely, it's the former secret that Hannah doesn't learn of until later).

The problem with this book is there is no emotional bridge getting you to all of the love scenes. While the one night stand and the beginning does serve a purpose, the interactions in between Hannah and Jack (the bear shifting Marine) come off as stiff and forced (ABSOLUTELY no pun intended).

There is no love. There is no emotion. They even deprive us of what could have been the most interesting part of the entire book -- the discovery. And that is another problem. By the time we catch up with Hannah, she knows all about this underground world where men shift to bears and back to men. So we really have no liaison talking us through the entire thing. Discovering the finer details of bear transformation as we discover them. Not enough time is spent building this world so you end up feeling you've been tossed to the wolves

without so much as a stick to defend you. Not enough world building is done to get you to feel like this is a fully-concieved universe, therefore it doesn't come off as all that believable.

At the end of the day, it is just way to much raunch and way too little emotion, plot and character development. And the description of love scenes between male and female bear shifters gets so damned confusing, at times you wonder whether something illegal is going on.
