I've been a Celia Loren fan for several years and always enjoy her books. I admit, I almost passed on this one since I've been a little burned out on all the sports and secret baby stories recently. The romance genre seems to have been flooded as of late with book after book of college and professional bad boy sports releases with all having a similar theme...handsome college bad boy athlete meets beautiful coed. They're an unlikely match but fall in love with numerous obstacles along the way. The sport varies but the storyline always remains the same. For this reason alone, I almost didn't read this book, and that would have been a big mistake. I decided to at least glance at the free sample, and so glad I did.

I was immediately drawn into the story by the two young adult protagonists, both strong, dynamic characters who captured my attention and my heart. I became instantly smitten with college senior Hunter Phillips, handsome star quarterback and total womanizer. I was also captivated by the sweet, lovely Britt McKay, smart college freshman and naive virgin. I immediately identified with Britt's character and felt as if we were kindred spirits, having had a similar experience in college. She and I both were only children which can sometimes lead to social difficulties in forming friendships as well as relationships. Unfortunately, Britt was not just an only child, she was also the daughter of the university's head coach who knew all too well how promiscuous college football players could be.
