Reawakened is book one in the Chronicles of Cas by E.M. Moore. I have read several of E.M. Moore's books and I think that this one is in a tight race for first place as my favorite. The storyline sounds out seemingly innocent but then it quickly kicks into high gear with trouble knocking at Cas's door. This story is fast paced and engaging from start to finish. I like the dynamics of the various characters in this story. There is a spark of romantic interest between Cas and her old childhood friend Jake.

I enjoyed this story but there were moments of where I felt that Cas's character was a bit juvenile. I don't get her sudden need to brag to him as many times that she does about her blades and her kills. He was there when they happened. So do me her being braggadocios are unnecessary. I also expected her to at least be chagrined a bit after he told her that "he was there." I also felt that there was a bit of a disconnect when they haven't seen each other in years and suddenly he starts being pretty hands on with her. I'd think that there would be some awkwardness at first.

I am rating this book 4.5 out of 5 stars. I enjoyed this story and am looking forward to the next book in this series. It has some surprises and twists that keep the reader engaged in the story. Cas is an interesting character and I'm eager to see where things go with her story and those who have allied themselves with her.
