It's not going to be easy, but Tide's going to have to convince Lance he belongs at Tide's side as both lover and sub.

With all of the books I have read in this genre, I had not read anything by Sean Michael and I thought I should rectify that. But, this book was definitely not the one for me and I can't say I will pick up another one from this author any time soon. It could have been the kind of book that you just have to go with the premise of it and move on and it depends on the book really if that's a viable option. But here, the set up right from Chapter One was not working for me at all and it only went further downhill from there.

Lance has been hired to shoot an exclusive deck of erotic playing cards. The client, who is entirely off page, will be paying Lance a fee that is said will cover Lance's rent for three years. Lance has absolutely no experience in the BDSM world, has no idea how to find adequate models, and then has absolutely no idea what kind of equipment or props he will need for the shoot. He came off as entirely unprofessional and all of this was more than I could let myself overlook.

Der Klappentext verspricht eine interessante Story, leider ähnelt sie eher einem Porno.

Zur Handlung. Als Photograph Lance den Auftrag für ein erotisches BDSM-Kartenspiel erhält, gestaltet sich die Suche nach geeigneten Modellen schwierig. Doch dann bewerben sich drei Männer um den Job, die Lance ziemlich durcheinander bringen.

Tide und seine Freunde, Tyrone und Bran sind überzeugte BDSM-Anhänger. Während Tyrone und Bran ein Paar sind, ist Dom Tide solo und auf der Suche nach einem geeigneten Sub. Der schüchterne Lance erregt sein Interesse, besonders als er spürt, dass Lance die gestellten Sessions nicht kalt lassen. Das Problem dabei ist, dass Lance absolut keine Erfahrung mit BDSM hat und nicht versteht, was Tide von ihm will.

Der neue Boy hat mir leider überhaupt nicht gefallen. Denn anstatt einer überzeugenden Story gab es nur Sex, Sex und wieder Sex. Die Charaktere blieben blass und eindimensional. Tide als Dom, der nur daran interessiert ist, Schmerzen zuzufügen und Sub Lance, der ziemlich willenslos erscheint. Wenn mal ein zaghaftes nein von ihm kommt, setzt sich Tide einfach darüber hinweg nach dem Motto, du meinst gar kein nein, weil es dir in Wahrheit gefällt. Besonders krass fand ich den Besuch im Piercingstudio. Lance, der eigentlich Panik vor Nadeln bekommt, wird quasi zum Nippelpiercing genötigt. Was die Szene noch besonders absurd und unglaublich macht, zwischendurch verlässt der Piercer den Raum, damit Tide und Lance Sex haben können.

Fazit, Porno ohne nennenswerte Handlung. Schade, aus der Idee hätte man durchaus etwas machen lassen.

trifft er auf Tide und seine Freunde, Tyrone und Bran. Eine aufregende Reise in eine andere Welt beginnt.

Leider schafft es das Buch nicht einen wirklich abzuholen. Man kann sich zwar in die Protagonisten hineinfühlen, jedoch erscheint das ganze etwas gekünstelt oder schlicht schlecht übersetzt? Lance, der von dem Lifestyle BDSM zwar schon einiges gelesen aber noch nie probiert hat, wird auf einen Weg geschickt, der anregend und spannend scheint, doch die Dialoge und Zwischensequenzen schaffen es einfach nicht, das Erlebte so rüberzubringen, dass man den Protagonisten eine einvernehmliche Zeit zuschreiben kann. Klar, Lance will es, doch Nein heißt nein.

This is classic Sean Michael and a fun story that is quick and easy to read. Sean's stories are not so much narrated to you as told to you through conversation and The New Boy is a good example of that.

Lance Packet is a shy and self-conscious photographer whose latest job is to produce a pack of playing cards with men as the models in various positions to do with BDSM. He has almost given up hope of finding the right models for the job when Tide, Bran and Tyrone walk through the door.

Tide and his best friend Tyrone run a gym that caters to men in the BDSM lifestyle. Tide also models and is

a Dom. Tyrone is also a Dom and Bran is his sub and they are committed to each other and very much in love but they include Tide in their relationship quite a bit. Right from the start the three men are very open and sexual with each other causing Lance to hyperventilate and spend a lot of time in the bathroom

Tide is almost immediately smitten with Lance but knows he will have to go carefully and slowly if he doesn't want to chase the shy man away. Lance has zero confidence in himself in anything he does except for his photography and over the years his camera has become his safety net and is definitely something he hides behind.

Once Tide has his sights set on him Lance doesn't stand a chance. He slowly comes out of his shell as they all work together and Tide continuously pushes him, albeit gently. There is, as usual, a lot of sex in this story both in couples and threesomes but as Tide realises he might just get what he wants he knows already he will be unwilling to share his New Boy.

There really is a lot of sex in this book with just a very mediocre story line. It's like anytime a topic came up that did need to be discussed, it turned into sex and I forgot what they were actually trying to figure out.

Tide just came off as a conceited, pushy man most of the time and it was annoying and distracting ALL OF THE TIME. I didn't really understand his relationship with Bran and Tyrone. It seemed to shift half way through the book and all of a sudden they were just best friends. Not people he hooked up with when on the beginning there seemed to be true intimacy between the three of them.

Lance had zero self-esteem. So many self put downs, both in his head and out loud. It had me feeling bad for him and that overshadowed him being an interesting character.

Lance ist ein junger, talentierter Photograph. Für einen neuen, lukrativen Auftrag braucht er gutaussehende Männer, die auch vor der Kamera keine Scheu zeigen und für explizite Fotos und Handlungen zu haben sind. Tatsächlich lassen sich diese Männer finden. Tide, sowie Tyrone und Bran. Die drei Männer sind schon sehr lange eng befreundet und teilen auch den gleichen Lebensstil. Während Tide Single ist, sind Tyrone und Bran ein Paar. Mehr noch – sie sind Dom und Sub.

BDSM fasziniert den jungen Lance, auch wenn er keine Erfahrungen damit hat. Überhaupt sind seine Erfahrungen etwas limitiert und er reagiert auf die Offenherzigkeit der Männer mit Scheu, aber auch mit Neugierde. Tide macht ihm Avancen, die Lance jedoch nicht versteht. Mit diesen Männern kann er doch gar nicht mithalten und so kämpfen Sehnsüchte gegen seine Unsicherheiten. Doch Tide ist ein erfahrener Dom, der in Lance einen Sub erkennt. Er fühlt sich zu dem schüchternen Mann hingezogen und setzt all seine Erfahrung und seinen Charme ein, um ihn zu erobern.

The New Boy ist eine nette, fluffige Geschichte, die jedoch nicht besonders in die Tiefe geht. Im großen und ganzen ist es ein gut geschriebener Porno mit wenig Hintergrundgeschichte. Macht aber nichts, wenn man in Stimmung für so eine Geschichte ist. Lance und Tide werden zwar beschrieben, aber besonders genau ist Sean Michael dabei nicht. Es reicht jedoch aus um zu wissen wer sie sind, was sie machen und wie es um ihre Gefühlswelt bestellt ist. Tide ist erwartungsgemäß cool, abgeklärt und erfahren. Allerdings ist er ein netter Kerl, der sich im Grunde auch nach einer engen und liebevollen Beziehung sehnt, wie Tyrone und Bran sie seit Jahren führen.

Lance hingegen muss sich erst mit seinen Gefühlen auseinandersetzen und auch seine Unsicherheiten überwinden. BDSM war nie sein Ziel, doch er fügt sich ziemlich schnell und passt sich Tide an, der ihn geschickt und erfahren führt und in diese fremde Welt einführt. Wie gesagt – die Geschichte ist nicht besonders tiefgreifend und zuviel Drama sollte man sich nicht erwarten. Aber manchmal braucht man ja auch genau solche Bücher.

Ursprünglich wurde obenstehende Rezension für das Original geschrieben. Allerdings möchte ich für die Übersetzung noch ein paar Ergänzungen machen. Diese hat mir nämlich nicht wirklich gefallen. Ich bin mir nicht sicher, ob es am Stil der Autorin liegt, oder an der Übersetzerin. Vermutlich aber ersteres. Sean Michael ist jetzt nicht bekannt für besonders tiefgründige Geschichten. Allerdings fällt die klebrige Wortwahl im Englischen nicht so auf. Oder man empfindet sie jetzt nicht als so anstrengend und flach.

In der Übersetzung kommt das jedoch dann ganz deutlich raus und das hat mich wirklich sehr genervt. Möglich aber, dass die Geschichte selbst wirklich so schlicht ist *lol* und ich sie beim ersten Mal einfach völlig anders wahrgenommen habe. Jedenfalls finde ich die Geschichte in der Übersetzung nicht wirklich spannend oder gar sexy. Das kam im Original besser rüber.

My personal issue with this one was that it felt like Tide, the Dom, was steamrolling Lance from the moment they met. Here's a guy who's shy, inexperienced, insecure, and Tide was all over him, basically not taking no for an answer, more or less pushing him into things that he ended up enjoying, but it was dubious consent at best to me. It seemed so out of character for a shy virgin to be willing to not only jump in the sack with a guy he'd JUST met, but then have sex in front of others and go bareback, all within a week or so.

So that took away from my enjoyment, but it was still a fun read aside from that.

Any new relationship is interesting and comes with its challenges, hopes, and deep feelings. Add BDSM of some kind to it, from mild to intense, and the picture becomes far more complicated - especially when one partner is far less experienced than the other. In the first book of what promises to be a great new series by Sean Michael, Lance and Tide don't just have an unusual first meeting, but quickly delve into an exciting and somewhat adventurous exploration of what promises to be an interesting relationship. 'The New Boy' is fun to read, has great characters (both main and secondary), and is very, very hot. It's also a great book for "BDSM beginners" or those who prefer to read about the lighter side of D/s play.

Lance is a photographer, and his newest client wants a set of BDSM cards with custom-made images. The idea made me smile, but when the most recent models Lance is interviewing walk in and Lance almost faints, I began to grin. The three men are professional models, well muscled, and clearly into the lifestyle. They are also good friends who like to work together, and seem to have no shame about exposing their bodies for the various positions Lance needs them in - for the photographs, of course. Tyrone and Bran are obviously a couple, and Tide shows more than a hint of interest in Lance. With Lance being as shy as he is and not at all knowledgeable about anything other than vanilla sex, my anticipation increased. Lance has no idea what to expect, but he is physically and mentally excited from the start.

Tide co-owns a gym, but he is also a model, and this newest assignment is right up his alley. He brings his best friend, Tyrone, and Tyrone's sub, Bran, with him for what promises to be an exciting shoot. But when they arrive at Lance's studio he takes one look at Lance and decides he is the cutest photographer ever. Tide being a Dom, he then sets out to "conquer" Lance's heart and obedience. It isn't easy, but Tide is determined and patient. The way he gradually introduces Lance to some D/s play, additionally courts him by taking him on dates and helps him become more self-confident makes for a very sweet and more than hot read. Their contract negotiation, when the time comes, is one of the cutest I have ever read. Tide stole my heart because he isn't just a great Dom, but also an amazing man.

If you like reading about men who fall in lust and love at first sight, if a BDSM beginner learning about what he likes and what he doesn't sounds interesting, and if you're looking for a read that is undeniably hot, full of sexy explorations, and very sweet, then you will probably like this novel. I adored it.
