This is book #2 of the Delaney Brother's Trilogy and I enjoyed it. The setting is Montana, 1880, and Chad Delaney is a bounty hunter who rides into town one night and rescues Sarah's son from a group of kids that were attacking him. Chad is falling for Sarah everyday that he is with her but he gets lucky to find out that Sarah is linked to the bank robber he is looking for.

Western historical romance with a bounty hunter that randomly helps a young unmarried mother when she has a bad burn accident. There is a series of seriously wicked guilt tripping that unfolds over the first few chapters as the bounty hunter, Chad Delaney tries to get help for Sarah Temple and her five year old bastard young son, Abner, but no one from her family or the community can or want to help her. She has been totally rejected and ruined by her own family because she got pregnant without marriage, even though it was through rape which is crazy since her father is the town pastor who should show some Christian forgiveness and compassion.

Let's not forget the reason that Chad is in town, he is tracking down a thief and generally bad person, Freddie who's hometown and who left town suddenly about five years ago and it isn't a coincidence that it was just before Abner's birth. So everyone (except Chad and the little boy) has secrets which is going to push forward the plot and drama in this story. There is a ton of story before the HEA. Like the Kidnapping (twice!) and the Indian group that turns out to be honorable but looking for freedom and food which was a kind view because we see the prejudiced 'European folks' view at the same time which was ridiculous. So after the HEA we get to see the beginning of the next book with the last brother, Ryan's love story start as an adventure to find a lost daughter for an old friend of the Delaney's brother's deceased father.

Another great 1990's romance novel by Connie Mason which just got re-published for kindle but there were quite a few conversion errors like 'men' for then and 'm' instead of 'th' is found at least 5 different times.
