The begging, first scene is not at all what I had worked up in my head, and in my reading and still now at the end, I'm asking myself, why, like others scenes in the books, they are unfold in this way.

I don't understand the come and go of the characters. I feel it doesn't bring anything to the story but get me a bit everywhere and in the end it doesn't move much the core of the story or the romance between the main
