It was fun visiting areas I've been in person on the pages of this book and imagining the story really happening.

Jamie Lynn doesn't believe for one minute her brother really was the driver in a hit-and-run homicide and she hates that he's spending 30 years in prison for a crime he didn't commit. Likewise, Shane's mother believes her husband was murdered and not by accident. The two women together are determined to find answers. Who really killed Sam Colton and was it an accident?
