This issue was a slog to get through. While the arc started out strong in Screaming Citadel #1, I honestly can say that I'm grateful it has now come to a close.

My reasoning:

- 1) the "Ravenloft"/mind control/Borg/Wrath of Khan/Aliens/whatever you want to call it, grew tiresome as I progressed through the series; especially by this issue
- 2) the artwork did not impress as I moved through the series (Mr Checchetto's in the premier issue was the strongest in my view; Ms Broccardo's the weakest)
