Jared was quite a jerk in the beginning and a real charmer after (oh and here comes the sarcasm) sweetly making love to our innocent nineteen - that's right, she's nineteen - year old virgin heroine. However, after that scene we really don't see a return to that asshat male.

Jared did have some issues, like the death of his daughter that he deals with in this book. Sara also has her own issues after a tragic childhood. I'm not sure why DP throws in these heroines that have some kind of brain impairment. This is the second one, that I can recall, with a heroine who has some kind of head trauma or similar. It is mentioned and then only briefly touched on in the book. I just think these little category romances don't really have the space to deal with something like that which is probably why it is mentioned once and then pretty much ignored through the rest of the book.

How these DP heroines stay so innocent is a bit ridiculous. It's a little hard to swallow at times but I still enjoy reading them. :)

However, I did enjoy the angst in this one and I liked the characters better in this one, than in Heartbreaker (Long, Tall Texans). This had a bit of that angsty goodness.
