So I found out this morning that "The Tornado" was plagiarized from a work called "In the Land of Gods and Monsters" by author Wynter S. Komen.

Can I just say that I'm seriously pissed and tired of hearing about this crap like every other week?

It's disgusting, unethical, shameful behaviour. It's incredibly disrespectful towards both authors and readers. And for what? To make a buck off of someone else's efforts and pull a fast one over the clueless audience?

Eff you, Missy Blue.

And that's about the nicest thing I have to say where you're concerned right now.

Here's some of what the author, Wynter S. Komen, has to say about the situation:

Some of you may have heard this by now, but I'm going to give you the deets here. Last night a fan fic member [...] informed me that my story, In the Land of Gods and Monsters, had been lifted and published by a person named Missy Blue and retitled The Tornado. This work is published under Amazon Kindle and she is making money off of it.

Additionally another fanfic friend, informed me that there is ANOTHER author by the name of DC Ruins who published a book called Dances With Monsters... two guesses where that story came from.

Dumbfounded, I had to see it for myself, and sure enough - there it was. I can't tell you the emotions that went through me when I saw it. Disbelief, shock, rage, and pure unadulterated HURT. Obviously, I'm a writer. I know that plagiarism is a thing that people do, but I never in a million years could have thought it would happen to me. And I hope it never happens to any of you, if you're writers, because the pain it causes is unreal. I am devastated and heartbroken.

Let me clarify, it has nothing to do with the financial benefit that both authors are obviously reaping. I am currently working on my first original novel. I am working hard to become a published author myself, because writing is my dream and my passion and the THING I was meant to do. I want to be able to make money off of writing and support myself with it, so I can, in effect, have my dream job.

But it's not about that, the money. For me, it's about the art, and moreover, the feelings. I came to fanfic almost three years ago and started posting stories over two and a half years ago. The story in question, Gods and Monsters, was written at the start of one of the most horrible and trying times of my life. It was therapy for me. I poured my heart into that story, I worked hard to create a character (Sammi) that people could feel for and relate to and root for. I worked hard to craft a revealing tale of romance and healing and hope, because that is what I needed at that time in my own life. That story was one that came from my soul, and to have it taken from me like that without a care in the world disgusts me and breaks my heart.

To Missy Blue and DC Ruins...SHAME ON YOU.

Shame on you for being thieves. Shame on you for not giving a f*ck about another person's feelings or work. And most of all, shame on you for having the AUDACITY to call yourself an artist. You're NOT an artist. You're a thief.

Learn to write. Go to school. See if you can develop your OWN talent and use that to line your bank account. But don't steal from real artists. This might be fanfiction, but those stories are MINE. And you know it. SHAME ON YOU.

UPDATE 2: *I have always wondered why an amazing author like Missy Blue didn't have a web page, FB page or even twitter (because I usually subscribe to authors I love) but figured that it was a pen name and I just hadn't figure out who the original author was. But it came as a shock to discover that the reason behind this anonymity is actually the fact that this novel has been stolen from another author and (with a few little modifications) published on Amazon.*

I was a little skeptic at the beginning when I saw some disturbing comments on my review and that's why I contacted Wynter S. Komen and here is her answer:

"Hi Cristina,

The link to the story I published March 2013 is here: <https://www.fanfiction.net/s/9099258/...>

In my story, my female character has been the victim of a violent sexual crime the previous year. She travels to a new city with her family to rebuild her life. She's a very gifted dancer and lost her love of performing but loves to teach. In an attempt to rebuild her confidence around men and try to get over her PTSD and also

build her physical strength, she disguises herself as a guy and goes to a local gym. There, she meets the hero. He notes this "boy" - he runs the gym so he makes a point to know all his patrons - and tries to talk to "him" but to no avail. One night some guys at the gym pick on the boy, start a fight, and rip his shirt, revealing that "he" is a "she". Thus, he comes to her defense and they begin a friendship.

He teaches her some self-defense techniques and is there for her during an anxiety attack. She invites him over for dinner one night and he learns of her past. He surprises her with tickets to her favorite ballet and she accompanied him to an MMA tournament he's fighting in. He clashes with her family after reporters get a hold of her story and air her "dirty laundry" at the tournament (hero is something of a hometown celebrity). He shows up at the trial where she bravely testifies against her rapist. He surprises her at the end by buying her the dance studio she's always wanted - after surprising her at her very first performance in over a year.

In the end, they make plans to live together, and the story closes with her showing him a special dance to a special song he inspired her to create.

I hope this helps.

I've contacted Amazon and Goodreads about the plagiarism. The story is no longer up on Amazon but I'm not sure about this site.

I hope this has no negative connotations for your review/followers. It's none of YOUR fault. She stole from me and lied to you. This isn't about me solely; it affects everyone.

After her message I went and checked out her link. This was my first time on www.fanfiction.net (although I have heard of it before) and after seeing with my own eyes that the story there matched pretty much of the text from this novel (it's like that story was taken and improved...but there are very large portions that are copied word for word) I just couldn't believe it.

The publish date on that site is listed as Mar 14, 2013 so I asked my hubby (who is a computer programmer) if there is any way that Wynter S. Komen could have set a prior date for her work and written reviews also with that date. His answer was that it would be possible (a little far fetched but still) only with the "help" of the persons that run that web page and being that this is a very popular and somehow famous online community I don't see them stopping so low.

Amazon has also deleted any trace of this novel or this author from their database...and it would be interesting to see their position on this matter.

So my conclusion is (in lack of any contrary evidence from this author) that Missy Blue has stolen the story from Wynter S. Komen and that, even with the modified text, this book still qualifies as a plagiarism because beyond the similar story line there are large portions of text copied word for word.

I'm sad to see that some people take advantage so blatantly of something that has helped a lot of indie authors to self publish, but like with a lot of things that are meant for good there are still people who can find ways to use them for something evil.

In the light of this current situation I have modified my rating for this novel from 5 to 1 star, but I will still be

keeping my previous review at the end so it doesn't confuse people.

Wynter S. Komen I'm sorry that this has happened to you and I wish you all the best with your writing.

UPDATE: I understand there are some allegations of plagiarism regarding this book. I have contacted the author that has raised this issue and I have also tried to contact the Missy Blue but I have found no means to do that. At this point my review still holds until I have sufficient evidence to back up these claims and modify what I have written about this book.

Asher “The Tornado” Prince is a former Marine, current MMA fighter who runs his partner’s gym in Pittsburgh. When a kid comes into his gym, looking to train and hiding under big baggy clothes, he wants to help. Except that kid isn’t a kid but a woman named Jewel Mucciarone, and she’s gone through some things. Very bad things, and she’s trying to put her life back together. And well, you know the drill, romance happens.

The Good, The Bad and Everything In Between

- Kickass blurb caught my eye : In the midst of so many misleading blurbs, and attempts to disguise serials and “trilogies” and other stuff in romances, I adored this:

Author Note: MATURE CONTENT 18+ Past descriptions of abuse, but nothing graphic. The Tornado is a new adult, mma fighter, sports romance novel. Asher is a **possessive alpha-male but with a HEART OF GOLD (No alpha-hole). NO CHEATING. NO CLIFFHANGER. STANDALONE. HEA. No annoying EX drama.** Book length: 100k words. Written in first person and from both POV.

It’s no BS, straight to the point and I couldn’t resist.

- **Favorite trope of mine** : Besides the blurb, the trope of “heroine dressing up as a boy” is a favorite of mine and not seen very often in contemporary romances. Now, it’s resolved very quickly, so Asher doesn’t look like an idiot for not seeing that she’s a girl. That said, I wouldn’t have minded seeing it last a little longer to play with the gender bending a little.

- **Long live Asher, the ideal alpha hero** : NO LIE. The man is fantastic and the main selling point of this story. He’s patient, kind, completely and utterly into the heroine and he doesn’t even look or pay attention to any woman other than Jewel. He’s caring, thoughtful, and practically perfect in every way. It’s a little scary, but true. He’s great.

- **Heartbreaking yet strong heroine** : Jewel has been through something horrific, which I think most readers can guess, and when the story begins, she’s still in the midst of her journey to finding her new normal. The blurb is honest (it’s all in the past), there’s enough told that my imagination raced and my heart broke for what she suffered and the long term implications of that horrible event. But while she struggles, she doesn’t feel sorry for herself. While I absolutely enjoyed Asher’s protective instincts, I loved that by the end of the story, she is the one doing the saving.

- **Slow burn** : Once Jewel shares what happened to her, it made absolute sense that their love scenes take their time to unfold. The anticipation built nicely and when it finally happens, it fit within the context of the story being told. But...

- **Awkward sexual references** : While I appreciated the sex and there are very hot moments, there’s also several awkward phrases, references to scrotums and groins and such that didn’t fit. It was like listening to a really cool song and suddenly there’s a couple of questionable notes that make you flinch. It’s not horrible, but it was noticeable.

- **The climax wasn’t my fave** : Considering how great Asher and Jewel’s slow build and really focused on their romance, I was a bit disappointed with the climax. I felt that most of the dramatic or action packed moments seemed to involve Jewel being a damsel in distress. The “villain” didn’t factor in until the final 20% and even then, he barely existed, which failed to really justify his over the top actions and final comeuppance. Between that, and the shallow stereotypical characterizations of jealous, skanky women, I just thought it could have been better.

- **But the epilogue made up for it** : It was the perfect little bow on the top of this love story.

The Bottom Line

Asher’s the shiznit. This is perfect for those who enjoy little to no relationship angst, MMA fighter romances and practically no WTF-ery. There’s good promise with this author and I’d be open to reading more from Ms. Blue.
