After bonding with Jasin and barely escaping the Black Dragon and the Onyx Army, Kira and her men are sailing to the Air Kingdom where she will bond with Auric. Naturally, their journey isn't smooth sailing. There are powerful, evil forces working with the current dragons and Kira and her men are only learning their magic. Still, when they work as a team they are strong. However, can they truly be the team they need to be? Slade is willing to perform his role but wants to keep his distance emotionally from Kira. Reven has already deserted Kira once. Auric has secrets that could destroy her trust. And once she learns more about their bond Kira doesn't even know if she has the right to ask the men to commit to her. The Air Kingdom brings quite the adventure.

Kiss the Sky picks up exactly where book one left off with absolutely no letdown. This is Auric's story and it's an entertaining adventure. Hurtful secrets, broken trust, and steamy lessons are all part of the Golden Dragon's story. We learn so much about the scholarly prince. His strength and confidence are starting to show more despite his cowardly deception. It's impossible not to understand his fear or to deny his devotion to Kira so I forgive him his mistake. Jasin has fully embraced this new life and is fully committed to Kira now. Gone is the one-night stand soldier. I like him so much better now. Slade and Reven are still reluctant to get close to Kira but their resistance is starting to crumble. Love it! We also learn more about Kira. Elizabeth Briggs has picked us up right where we left off in Stroke The Flame, with Kira and her four Dragons heading towards the Air Realm. This book has been written well with the pace being just right to allow for each Dragon to have their own tale (even with all the characters involved). While we went to the Fire Realm for Jasin in book 1, this time we get to see the different culture surrounding the Air Realm with Auric, along with all the rigmarole that goes with being Royalty. However, even though this book is centred around the bonding with Auric, we still get to see each characters personality and their interactions with the other characters (i.e. Reven hiding in the shadows but making comment on others feelings, and Jasin providing a little fire and assistance when needed).

I listened to the audiobook version of this book.

Kiss the Sky picks up where Stroke the Flame leaves off. It is a very fast paced listen and seemed to be over before I knew it! In this one we get to see their journey as the return to the place where Auric is from and we get a lot more detail about him and his background. We also get to learn some more surprising information about Kira and her background. Now that we know who all of the main characters (mostly) are from the first book, the author is able to establish real relationships and connections between Kira and her men. It is a little predictable since we are able to have a general idea of where the author intends to take the story; however, the author is able to keep us engaged with how she takes us there and through these charming characters. There are also some pretty steamy scenes as Kira and her men start to become closer with one another.

These narrators did a fantastic job in this performance. Each kept character voices consistent and differentiated from the first book.
