The brother owes money to a gangsta that has his eye on the main character. The thug tries to give her an offer she can't refuse. She is torn between bailing her brother out once again or remaining faithful to her imprisoned boyfriend.

It sounds dramatic, right? Oh how wrong you would be, dear friends. First, the characters are ALL static and painfully cliché. As for drama, there are two death scenes in the story. They basically play out like this, "He shot him." THAT was the dramatic death scene.

After the "build up", the story turns into a pornographic fairy tale. The boyfriend is magically released from
