As handsome, witty, fun and charming as Prince Quinn was in The Playful Prince, Prince Reid his brother (one of two twins) could just as easily be called The Playboy Prince as much as the Rogue Prince. This was another great addition to the Lords of the Var Series (Dragon Lords).

Getting a break from life on Quirllixen, Reid takes to space with brother Jarak on an Ambassadorial mission. On the way the hilarious crew (which Jarak inherited from Princess Sam) stop at the Galaxy Playboy mansion where Reid entertains and outlasts three of the mansions finest playmates. He is apparently what all women want whether they know it or not. Irresistible, gorgeous, cocky and aware that he is a "chick magnet" Reid sees no reason to ever settle down like his brothers.

After completing his mission and accepting the honors bestowed upon his people he and the crew plan on wondering thru space having a few more adventures before returning home. Little does he know there is a stow away aboard their spacecraft.

Jasmine, the beautiful trophy wife of a prominent doctor has been abused and drugged to be kept in a state of emotional numbness. Her husband has been physically and mentally abusive while deceiving her into believing she was critically ill. She realizes that she must take this last chance to escape her husband and fleeing for her life bravely hides herself on Jarek's ship. Once she is out of hiding and Feeling for her predicament the crew decides to help her . Reid to his surprise becomes extremely protective and possessive of the beautiful refugee.

Reid is an awesome character and I did come to admire and like Jasmine more as the story progressed. Their complicated relationship and situation plays out wonderfully as they overcome difficult and dangerous situations and complications. Loved how confused Reid becomes when Jasmine doesn't fall immediately into his arms, and how Jasmine eventually finds her own strength, independence and voice. The Rogue Prince is the fourth book in the Var Prince series. It is the story of Jasmine St. Claire and Prince Reid, how they overcame so many challenges and found love with each other.

Jasmine is the wife of a doctor who is very interested in joining the Medical Alliance, aka. the Medical Mafia. She has endured years of physical, verbal and mental abuse from her husband. She is forced to be the prim and proper doctor's wife while she is dying inside. While at a medical conference, she sees the twin Var princes for the first time during a presentation of a thank you gift to the family of a doctor that was killed during the removal of a biological weapon from the planet of Qurilixen. When finds out she won the door prize of a new medical booth, she tries to bargain with Reid for a ride off the planet and away from her husband. She really becomes desperate to get away once she hears her husband, Chad, speaking with one of the Medial Mafia doctors and hears Chad mention that they were discussing starting a family. She decides to stowaway on their ship.

Reid is the Var Commander of the Outlands. He is also loves women and is a player. The book starts with Reid in the bedroom on the Galaxy Playmate mansion with three of the Playmates surrounding him. He and his twin, Jarek, are on their way as Ambassadors to attend a medical conference in order to present an award/thank you gift since their brother who is the Ambassador won't leave his very pregnant wife. After the presentation, he meets Jasmine for the first time. He is very taken with her but turns down her request for a ride off planet. Reid has trouble getting Jasmine out of his mind. He dreams about her the night they take off and he can't figure out why. Especially when the dream is of them talking without him trying to seduce her. He is very shocked when two of crew ask where she is since they saw her board before they left. She panics once they find her and they get boarded by people looking for her. In order to save her from being taken back to her abusive husband, Reid transforms into a Var tiger and uses his body to hide her. Jasmine can't help but pet him while the room is checked. Reid waits another half hour to make sure the men are gone and find Jasmine asleep.

Reid has an uphill battle to get past all of Jasmine's defenses. Being abused for four very long years has made her especially wary of men. She doesn't know how to take him. Jasmine was told so many times how useless and frigid she was that she started to believe the lies. She was also lied to about the medication she was given by Chad thinking it was for her heart when it was to make her more docile. Reid can't help but fall in love with her as he works to help her overcome the abuse and become the woman she was always meant to be. There is also the abusive husband that must be dealt with before she can fully become his life-mate.

This is such a touching book. I love how patient and kind Reid is with Jasmine. He changes his whole world to be with her and she blossoms under his love. This is another great love story by a great author.

With mysticism offered in explanation more often than 'science' and sexuality emphasized over plot, readers may derive more a feeling of fantasy romantica than sci-fi.

The heroine, Jasmine, is a doctor's trophy wife with an unspecified heart condition. On the run from her abusive husband and, subsequently, the 'medical mafia,' she sneaks aboard the vessel of departing diplomats after they initially refuse her safe passage. Coming across as weak and stoic, she wants only to flee and start life over.

Reid is an alien were-kitty prince who, despite a high opinion of himself, starts out about as charming as a hangnail. We are introduced to him in the aftermath of a foursome at an intergalactic playboy mansion. Proud, vain, crude, and seemingly dimwitted, he unfortunately makes for an unsympathetic hero.

The book itself would have benefited from another round of editing, as the frequency of errors was a bit distracting. While the writing style isn't at all unpleasant, readers can expect an overabundance of weak modifiers like 'really' and 'so', along with a tendency to overexplain. This reviewer also felt needlessly misled about the extent of Jasmine's abuse history up until about halfway through, when there happens to be a convenient telepathic intervention.

The immature bantering and masculine interpersonal relationships between the ships crew members lent the most authenticity to the story. There is some character development, at least. The hero is tolerable by the end, and the heroine makes some advancements regarding her views on sex and family. Though the pacing is steady throughout, the climax is more anticlimactic, as the driving action seems to fizzle out.
