Basically this serial is about two people with very little in common, having a wild affair, and then being magically in love at the end. It's sort of amazing how unrealistic these people are and how much I cannot relate to them.

Tori and Smith are equally ridiculous. Smith seems to think he's the holy grail of a virile man with money.
