This was a pretty good story. I liked both Buck and Amy and enjoyed their story.

Amy is the sister of Matt and best friend of Reenie (the MCs from book # in the series Stark Naked). Amy co-runs the family ranch with Matt. She's had a lot of bad luck with past boyfriends and decides to be more

cautious in the future. Unfortunately (or maybe fortunately), when she meets Buck she finds it very hard to take things slow.

Buck used to be a rodeo star but also had a rough time that ended up in him drinking and getting framed for rape (which luckily didn't work). He left the rodeo circuit and used his savings to buy a ranch and get it up and going. He just bought a ranch and was headed to a cattle auction when he meets Amy. Buck is sure a classy lady like her wouldn't give him the time of day and tries to act indifferent to keep his distance. It doesn't work too well though because he can't seem to stem the attraction he feels for her.

When Amy first meets Buck she's strongly attracted to him but his act of indifference makes her think he's a jerk and she decides to stay away. Later, when she gets home, her brother Matt says he knows Buck and they decide to invite him to dinner (even though Amy does have some reservations). Amy ends up running in to Buck a short time later and she invites him to dinner. Buck accepts and also seems more interested in her than their first meeting which leaves her confused. She's not sure what to think of him running hot and cold but she decides to just go with it for now. When he comes to dinner, Matt, Reenie, Amy and Buck all have a nice dinner but the attraction between Buck and Amy is very strong and obvious enough that Matt and Reenie both feel it. Amy ends up agreeing to go out with Buck the next night (and he informs her she will be spending the night). They go out and have a fun time (except for the brief appearance of an asshole ex of Amy's) and they do end the night at his place, engaging in some scorching of the sheets. This starts Buck and Amy seeing each other and we get to see a bit more as they spend more time together. A short (but undefined) amount of time later, they end up at a charity ball together and things are going well until Amy's ex decides he's going to tell her about Buck's past to try to break them up (but he lies and exaggerates the story, trying to make Buck seem horrible and trying to make out like Buck actually raped someone when he didn't). Amy doesn't believe her ex but does jump the gun a bit by running off when Buck doesn't tell her the whole story immediately. Buck's upset by her leaving and goes home trying to figure out what to do now. Amy ends up talking to Matt and finding out the truth and then has to make things right with Buck. The story ends with what would probably be more of a HFN (Happy for Now) ending since they're really just starting to date but it looks very encouraging for the future.

This was a good story. I liked the characters a lot (except for the ex but we're not supposed to like him) and was happy that Buck and Amy were able to work things out. The story was kind of short but it worked since Amy and Buck weren't "in love" at the end, just set up so it seems likely they'll end up that way in the future. Good addition to the series and an enjoyable way to spend a few hours. :)

So I returned from The Sassy Seven's Naughty Sleepover to find the next book in my review queue to be from none other than the Godmother of the group, Desiree Holt. I'll admit I felt a little a little uneasy going in to this one because 1) I'd just met the woman, ate with her, danced with her, shared strippers with her, and visited a dungeon with her 2) she's Desiree Holt someone who I admire greatly and 3) she's a freakin' hero to so many in the romance world. That being said, I put on my big girl panties (well not really, but metaphorically speaking) and set out to review the second book in her Naked Cowboy series. I really loved the first book in this series; it was funny, sassy, and of course extremely satisfying in every department. Buck Naked is every bit as enjoyable as the first book, but it has a more serious feel to it. However, I found the sex scenes to be more intense and completely fulfilling over and over again!

We met Amy Stark in book one, her brother met and fell in love with her ex-college roommate and good friend. Amy hasn't had the best track record when it comes to men and when a sex on legs man happens along to help her change a flat tire she knows he's completely wrong for her. Her body though has its own ideas and she has a hard time telling it no.

Buck Montgomery has moved to this small Texas community to escape his former life and the shadows that haunt him. He's made some good friends including Amy's brother, Matt. He hopes his past has been left behind but he knows in his heart it is only a matter of time until it rears its ugly head. When he meets Amy he knows she's exactly the kind of woman he should steer clear of but the overwhelming attraction he feels for her can't be denied.

Right off the bat these two meet and the heat just rises up off the page and engulfs you. Even though Buck comes across as a class A jerk, you get a sense that he's putting on a front but you don't know why. Amy is instantly attracted but she doesn't want to be and she tells herself over and over she doesn't want or need someone like him in her life. However each time they meet it becomes more and more obvious it's not a matter of if but when they will give in to their attraction. I'll admit when Buck issues the invitation...no that's not quite right, the command for dinner, it gave me a little thrill especially when he says "Oh, and don't expect to be home before morning." Can you say, "hell yeah!" I do admire Buck for trying to tell Amy he's not good for her and giving her ample opportunity to stay away. However, I also like that Amy wasn't scared to take on this complex man.

I very much enjoyed this story even Buck's deep, dark secrets and Amy's last ugly relationship coming around to cause trouble. Even though this is a novella and the relationship progressed rather quickly, I found the characters to be well developed something I'm always extremely grateful for. Overall, Buck Naked is an entertaining and enjoyable story. The characters are sassy and fun, the dialog interesting and amusing, and the sex scenes scorching hot.
