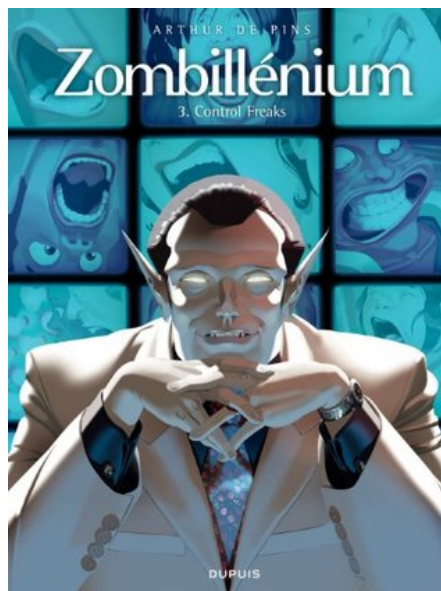

The latest volume of the hilarious Zombillenium series brings us back to the titular amusement park as rumors begin to fly about the Main Office sending a "consultant" to review operations. Everyone has their own take of what to expect from Beauford Jagger Carnegie III, a Louisiana Vampire with a reputation as a predatory (literally) corporate shark.

It turns out that they have good reason to feel uneasy, and even Francis can't calm people's nerves. When a girl tries to commit suicide in the park (after being dumped by her boyfriend), she is saved by Gretchen who sends her on her way with the advice to simply forget him. The girl keeps on visiting the attractions but nothing phases her anymore. Even the Haunted House, where each visitor is confronted by a tailored example of whatever scares them most. When the best attempts of Francis' technicians and Sirius fail to frighten her, Jagger asks to give it a try... and proceeds to violate the Park's first rule: "Don't harm the visitors."

An enraged Francis attempts to put an end to this (and Jagger) but is trumped by Jagger presenting him with a new policy, signed by the owner: Park employees are now ALLOWED to harm visitors.

With the head office undermining Francis' authority in order to boost revenues (in terms of both money AND souls), its left to the employees to stand up for what they want. And while Sirius and Aton organize a strike among the zombie unions, others take to the new rule like a duck to water... and park recruitment is on the rise! Even Aurelian feels the urge (prompted by Jagger) to vent his anger and frustration on the visitors, but Gretchen talks him down in a scene that is as twistedly funny as it is romantic.

But... when the strike fails, one of our beloved characters gets fired (and we all know what that means by now.) and with Francis out of the CEO chair, the future is looking more bleak than ever for our heroes. Unlike the other volumes, this one ends on a cliffhanger, and I eagerly await volume 4 to see how all of this plays out. (Alright, I'm actually screaming on the inside wanting to know what happens next, but I can say 'eagerly awaiting', can't I?)

The characters in this volume are now fully fleshed out and realized. Its been 2 years since the first volume, and it speaks volumes for Aurelian's personal journey that he has now not only made a kind of peace with his condition, but is trusted enough to be put in charge of a new "support group" for the large volume of new recruits to the Park.

We find out a lot more about Gretchen and what is motivating her. We see how much the Park means to Francis. Aton and Sirius get a lot of play here, and whats more is that we can actually \*feel\* a sense of family among our central players. And seeing their family under assault by a Corporate shark creates a surprising amount of tension.
