Remember in Stain (KH #2) when we notice major tension between Jay and Angel while Meeka and Asher were getting ready to go undercover? This story actually takes place during the same time, hence the 2.5. Although some of the dialogue we read is a repeat, we learn more about Jay's past with Tyler and how it's been effecting her and her relationship with Angel.

Angel is still the amazing man we grew to know and love and I fell just a little harder (if that's even possible) for him in this one again. Jay is healing. Not very well, but she's trying. Or at least she wants everyone to think that she's trying to get over the fact that her sister ISN'T dead, that she was captured and emotionally tortured by Vega and that she's not completely pissed off that Meeka and Asher were in on it. This was a 3.5 star read for me. It was an overall enjoyable read, but I felt like the two main characters had taken several steps back in terms of their personal development, as well as that of their relationship.

My overall impression of Jay when I read Grit was that she was a ‘balls to the wall’, no-nonsense heroine. She knew what she wanted in life and when Angel comes in, she has to adapt and change her vision of her future to include him. Fast forward several months and we are at Grim’s timeline. Jay behavior is that of a four year old that doesn’t get her way. She is incessantly whining.

Maybe it was my own expectations, however I found this story’s focal point to be on her relationship with her ex, Tyler. It’s almost like Angel is an afterthought, trying to be supportive, but cast on the sidelines. I felt like the story revolved around the three of them, and there was not much continuation of major plot lines from the first installment (ie. Human trafficking, the Harlots, Vice-One).

I think this would have been better integrated into another novel, with a few chapters from Jay and Angel’s points of view.
