This was my favorite story in the anthology (and that's saying a lot, because this is one of the best anthologies I've ever read).

"I want you ... like in every possible way I can think of. I don't mean just sex, because sex is the easy bit. I want all the stuff that's not so easy with you too—I want you to hold me when I'm hurting and forgive me when I'm wrong."

All his life, Jess has been drawn to bad boys, but then he meets David and everything changes.

David is shy, almost unbearably so, but he knows what he wants. David finds Jess on the street playing his guitar and singing his heart out for pocket change.

David is NICE; he's nice, and he's drawn to Jess like a moth to a flame. But Jess has been hurt and only does one-offs. Until David. Until a cape and a blizzard and an accident. And the realization that sometimes you find something right and meaningful, and you shouldn't let it go.

Suki Fleet is a brilliant writer; her prose is flawless and captivating. I was utterly swept away by David and Jess, who are such complex characters. They are young and brave. And real.

Not too impressed with this. I felt the relationship between David and Jess was focusing more on the physical attraction. It felt one sided, most especially, like David felt more on the emotional level compared to Jess.
