I received this book in exchange for an honest review from NetGalley.

A Taste Of Sauvignon is the third book in Heather Heyford's debut series, the Napa Wine Heiresses. This book follows the eldest sister, Sauvignon 'Savvy' St Pierre.

Savvy decided at the age of thirteen that she would become a lawyer. She's working for a small law firm in her hometown in Napa Valley and is being assigned her very first case. On her way to her firm's weekly meeting she accidentally hits the neighboring farmer's chicken with her car when it runs out into the street.

She doesn't know much about the neighbors since she and her sisters were sent away to boarding schools on the East Coast when they were young and then they attended college thereafter. The St. Pierre's cook Jeanne is friends with the neighbors since she's been buying vegetables from their farm stand for years. Savvy knows that her father, famous vintner Xavier St. Pierre, does not see eye to eye with them, but she doesn't know why.

Savvy meets the neighbors when Mrs. Morales and her son Esteban come out to her car to retrieve the chicken she hit. Savvy is awestruck by Esteban the "agrilicious, king-sized man in faded jeans."
