Overall, I liked this story. It was an interesting read. There were a couple parts that made it harder for me to read than it could have been, but otherwise, a good read. The story line was unique – not the usual romance story line/theme.

The main characters were likeable and strong. It takes guts to do what Allison did – taking a chance to leave her current situation. The fact that Mason was willing to allow her to stay in his car is amazing. Fate stepped in for both of them.

I struggled a bit with the conversion between Allison and Mason's voices. I think it would have helped to add some type of demarcation or symbol noting when the voice changes.

The other part that made it difficult to read were the tense changes. I noticed in a number of sections, the verb tenses changed (present to future, past to present, etc). That made it a little confusing to read.

With those two exceptions, I enjoyed the book. There were a number of plot twists that I didn't see coming, which I enjoy.
