Knox was born unwanted. He's never had anyone to hold him or love him. As a result he lives with a hole in his chest that nothing will ever be able to fill. The only time or place he finds any satisfaction is when he's in the ring. When Jade comes into his life as much as he desires her and wants her for himself, he realizes that she's simply using him to further her investigation into a murder.

Blackmailed and sexually harassed into having sex with the Chief of Police, in order to gain a promotion that she has worked so hard for, Jade is determined to break open the current mafia case so she can move elsewhere. The men in her life have used her selfishly and cruelly and as a result she finds herself turning the tables on Knox to gain the information she needs. Ironically, the very actions she uses against him, works against herself as she quickly falls into desire with the very man she absolutely should not be crossing lines with.

Knox and Jade's story pretty much runs concurrently with the previous two books of the series, Cain and Ivan. The beginning between these two was fast and a bit shocking as Jade makes some decisions that definitely cross professional conduct. As their story progresses, outside forces continue to push one or the other – usually Knox – into taking some action that puts distance or stumbling blocks between these characters. There are so many ways this author impresses me so that I continue to devour her work. Ms. Hart adapts her voice to the personality of the character telling the story, which makes the reading authentic and so effortless the words practically read themselves. Mechanically, the final product is carefully crafted, beautifully edited and as perfectly proofed as I've ever seen which makes for a delightfully smooth read. She knows just how much push and pull to employ in tugging the reader's emotions around and then balances that impeccably with solid conclusions and resolution to leave the reader satisfied and content. I felt that Jade was a bit hypocritical. Her brothers are both criminals, which she seems to be okay with. She still loves them unconditionally. Yet when she sees Knox as being a criminal, she judges him so hard and sees the absolute worst, not only as a lover, but as a father figure. I also thought Jade brought petty drama to the book. Like purposely going into Escapades when she sees Knox enter, going off on him because deep down she's jealous and insecure. Knox tried to show her he's being legitimate and legal with managing the club, and trying to be a better person.
