I'm reviewing my own book here. Actually, I love the way it reads. It's refreshing and straight forward. Four stars because I'm trying to be objective. I started working on the manuscript around 2000. Since I don't read Sanskrit my primary source was Kisari Mohan Ganguli's monumental, first ever, complete English translation, taking 13 years and completed in 1896. Over 25 years ago a theater compatriot and myself worked the Mahabharata as a two man, two hour staged drama where we each played several roles, including that of storytellers moving the story along. Later I included Mahabharata in my repertoire of solo dramatic storytelling I offer professionally. In 2001, after seeing the first part of The Lord of the Rings, I saw the full potential of Mahabharata and that it could authentically be pulled off as an epic film. Thus the intent of my own rendition was twofold: delivering the story as good literature and as the basis for a great film.
