She works in the mail sorting center at the FBI and volunteers weekly at a no kill animal shelter. The only thing she does have is a mysterious internet/e-mail relationship with a guy who is named Watts. She doesn't know anything about him other than that one name.

Watts is the owner of a rare bookstore where he buys and sells books. He has a privacy code rule with women- one night and you will never see him again. He does it to protect them and himself.
