Although part of a series, this book has sufficient resolution to be read as stand alone. There are spoilers, if you haven't read any of the previous books. (Situation outcomes of previous characters that are included in this storyline.) This is Tristan and Felicity's story. A quick read (about an hour) that is fast paced and loaded with wonderful characters. Despite this being my first Dragon Guard series read, at book 31, I enjoyed the read and didn't feel lost. A fun, feel good read that will have you wanting to read the series from the beginning.
