She had been both extremely verbally and physically abused by her mother since a very young age, and I can see where she'd have no self esteem. But the psycho mother was evil as well. She enjoyed throwing her food on the floor and making Harley eat it off the floor; dirt, hair, lint and all. Totally disgusting.

Harley was a bit of a Cinderella really. She got to do all of the housework, all of the cooking and she worked to support her mother, as her mother lied so she could live off from government checks and never have to work at a real job.
