The characters in this book have phenomenal chemistry and the author makes both women so likeable in completely different ways. It's a lot of "opposites attract" on a superficial level but then you get to know the characters on a deeper level and realize they're not so different after all.

This book has some of the best sexual banter I've read but if I'm honest it falls short in the physical act of sex by comparison. Maybe it's because they only ever seem to have sex or "fuck" and don't ever seem to make love, not even once, that leaves me unsatisfied. Or maybe it's the artificial use of a sex toy that makes their first time having sex and the last so impersonal, unemotional, not romantic, in my eyes. They are a sexy couple, extremely attracted to one another physically but emotionally I feel we are robbed of knowing the depth of how they feel.
