This was better than "Fugitive Bride", but it's let down by a disappointing ending. The main character is Lacey Miles, who is still grieving the death of her sister and brother-in-law in a bombing that was meant for her. She now has custody of her niece, and needs a nanny, as she feels over her head caring for a 2 year old. In steps Jim Mercer, who has been hired to protect her, and he manages to step in as the nanny in question, and ends up helping her find who planted that bomb.

I liked the main characters, which always helps! I find a tough, stoic hero who is great with kids to be quite swoon-worthy! Jim is the sort of hero I like reading about! I also liked Lacey, and I was able to get behind her drive to find out who was behind the bombing. The book also did a good job within its brief length to explore her doubts about being a good mother to Katie while never questioning her devotion to her niece. The romance between them was understated (which is generally typical of this line), but believable.

While the book wasn't action-packed, there was an undercurrent of tension, which is just as good, in my opinion! However, the ultimate explanation behind all the mayhem was disappointing and (view spoiler) was a total cop-out. This book never addresses some of those bizarre out-of-place plot strands brought up in "Fugitive Bride" that I mentioned in my review, further rendering that book a bit of a mess! Also, having Alexander Quinn be this magical all-powerful being who can get anyone out of a mess at any time really robs the book of suspense! This book would have been much better without him in it at all!

All in all, it was diverting and enjoyable, with a bit of suspense. It also looks like Paula Graves' last book for the time being.
