Together they form a comprehensive collection of Tolkien's own illustrations for his most popular books. Also included are many of his beautiful designs showing patterns of flowers and trees, friezes, tapestries and heraldic devices associated with the world of Middle-earth. In their variety and scope they provide abundant visual evidence of the richness of his imagination. Christopher Tolkien's text gives detailed notes on the sources for each picture.

Prachtband voller zauberhafter Zeichnungen

Eine beeindruckende Veröffentlichung: Sehr großformatig (32 x 32 cm), dickes Fotopapier, ein stabiler Hardcoveeinband mit einem in Gold geprägten Tolkien-Initial, geschützt von einem schön gestalteten Schutzumschlag, lassen dieses Buch auf jedem Kaffeetisch toll wirken.

Doch neben dem Angebe-Effekt findet sich für den Tolkien-Freund in diesem Band viele interessante Einblicke in die Welt Mittelerde, wie der Erfinder sie selbst sah: Jede Seite präsentiert in tadelloser Reproduktionsqualität eine Zeichnung des Autors, auf der gegenüberliegenden Seite einen kurzen Kommentar dazu. Hier findet man alles, von einfachen Bleistiftskizzen, über teilkolorierte Zeichnungen bis hin zu voll ausgearbeiteten Aquarellen. Gerade letztere zeigen, dass Tolkien durchaus neben seinem literarischen Werk auch künstlerische Ambitionen hegte, denn sie sind durchweg sehr ansprechend und in Detailgrad und Ausführung schon fast als professionelle Illustrationen zu bezeichnen.

Wer wissen will, wie Tolkien sich Mittelerde vorstellte, kommt an diesem Werk nicht vorbei.
